


Biography 307BW/STARBASE Louisiana

Mrs. Kara Reeh (Parks) is an instructor with the STARBASE Louisiana 2.0 program, sponsored by the Department of Defense at Barksdale Air Force Base. She collaborates with the 2.0 Coordinator to develop an engaging and rigorous curriculum aligned with STARBASE objectives, national STEM standards, and engineering practices for middle and high school students within the 2.0 program.
